Douglas M. Matton bio:

He performed his undergraduate studies at the University of Michigan, and received his juris doctor from the John Marshall Law School in Chicago, Illinois. His practice concentrates in civil litigation and contractual matters. When the foreclosure crisis started in 2007 he was instituting litigation against lenders for violations of the Truth In Lending Act.
