Virginia "Ginny" Parsons has been on the forefront of foreclosure defense since late 2009. As a



paralegal with the ability to research case law since the 1970s, Ginny realized that something was dreadfully amiss when foreclosures started rolling in like a tsunami with no end in sight. She began to gather information and took it to several local attorneys before she met Gary Dubin, who understood the pieces of the puzzle she had begun to uncover.
